WARD HALL

This national landmark built circa 1857 is believed to be the largest Greek Revival house in Kentucky and one of the finest in the South. Tour guides describe the elaborate parties of the late 1800s, famed

Approximately 30 miles north, the Ark Encounter is a one-of-a-kind historically themed attraction built to resemble Noah's Ark. In an entertaining, educational, and immersive way, it presents a
